Items from members of the public

P C Dee Stanley and PCSO Claire Doughty were present and updated members of various police activities. Youth Cllr Gill reported people smoking behind the Leisure Centre, particularly on Tuesday evenings. It was agreed that this be reported when they were seen. PCSO Doughty reminded members that the police relied on people calling them. In response to a question about anti social behaviour, PCSO Doughty explained the levels they went through towards obtaining an ASBO or CRASBO. She also stated that crime was low in Persnore town, although there had been a recent spate of rural thefts. PCSO Doughty reminded members to dial 101 if they needed to report anything.

Youth Cllrs King and Gill agreed to speak to Mr Hanson about these possibilities and Youth Cllr Archer agreed to speak to Mrs Herbert.
