366. Public Transport in the area

Members raised the issue of passengers being unable to purchase a train ticket at Pershore station which, on many occasions, meant they travelled to Worcester or Evesham without having to pay. This meant that passenger numbers were also distorted. Cllr Gillmor advised that this has been brought to the attention of Great Western Railway but to date they had not felt able to install such a machine. He also advised the meeting that concerns were being raised by the Town Council that the traveller number statistics being distorted in this way could have a detrimental effect on the number of trains calling at Pershore station.

The Clerk agreed to forward a link to the GWR consultation so that members could complete it should they so wish.

367. Policing in Pershore

The Clerk will ascertain whether a member of the Safer Neighbourhood Team might be available to attend the March meeting and also see whether a further visit to Hindlip was possible.

Youth Cllr Gill advised that youths were again gathering outside Asda and this was causing concern to users of the store as well as staff. The Clerk will speak to the police to see whether the local PCSOs can visit the area more regularly.
