House games in the hall	It was agreed this may be better postponed until the new academic year.
Coffee morning	The Clerk reminded the meeting that this would take place on 23 rd June at the Town Hall.

429. Pershore Carnival

Members noted that £17.45 was raised at Pershore Carnival and the Youth Mayor thanked those who helped on the day.

430. Environment issues

Youth Cllr Archer advised that the Environment Group were intending to install compost bins, off the ground, and use the compost for floral displays around the school. Mr Hanson advised that there was an issue with rats and students were being asked to be vigilant about leaving food around school.

431. Riverside Youth Centre

Members agreed that the centre did serve a purpose but there was no one present in the meeting who felt they would go there.

432. Christmas Light switch on

In the absence of Cllr Parsons this was deferred to the July meeting.
